"The Rock Garden of Chandigarh"

People paid to visit the garden. Nek put collection centres around the town so that he could make more recycled sculptures.

However, the garden wasn't safe yet. In 1990, the local _____ tried to build a road through the park, just for VIPs. But local people protested, and their plan failed. Later, Nek became famous. He _____ to the USA to tell people about his garden. But when he returned, his garden was destroyed! It took a long time to rebuild it and keep it safe.

Now, a charity manages the garden. Five thousand visitors visit this special place each day. Volunteers, workers, and local children still work here. They keep the garden clean and learn to make sculptures. If you like, you can volunteer here too!
